ONCE YOU ARRIVE AT THE MUSEUM ...

There is not a timed entry to the museum. However, the museum uses a virtual line for the *Van Gogh and the Avant-Garde: The Modern Landscape* exhibition. When you arrive at the museum, you can check into the virtual line by following the steps below. If you do not have a smartphone, museum representatives in the lobbies can assist you.

- Using the camera on your smartphone, scan the QR code located on the sign near the entrance to the galleries. This will bring you to a page that will allow you to join the virtual line by selecting the exhibition, and then entering the number of guests in your party.
- After confirming your spot in the virtual line, you are welcome to visit some old favorites and current exhibitions throughout the galleries. There is no need to wait near the Van Gogh exhibition entrance to hold your place—with virtual lines, you now have the opportunity to see even more during your visit!
- The museum will keep you informed about your place in line by sending updates to your phone through text message. When it is close to your time to enter, they will let you know to head over to the exhibition.

Guests are welcome to visit the museum anytime between 11 a.m. – 5 p.m. Association Staff will meet in the lobby at 10:30 a.m. to walk to the Art Institute as a group.
